Three easy ways to save fuel and your tires

Maintain your tire pressure!



A vehicle with low tire pressure requires more fuel to propel it forward.

Maintain your wheel alignment!



Just a small amount of misalignment causes early and uneven tire wear and reduces fuel efficiency.



Rotate and balance your tires regularly!



Most all-season tires need periodic rotation and balance to maximize tire life.

Did you know



As little as 1/32" of wear on 4 tires can cost \$60 to \$95 in replacement cost.



It requires 7 gallons of crude oil to produce the average passenger car tire.



Even small amounts of misalignment increases fuel consumption, causes premature tire wear and reduces vehicle safety.



Periodic alignment checks and corrections help maximize tire life and minimize fuel consumption.
